It does not consider any assets, savings or other property owned by the older person(s). A sample service price of \$20 is used as an example. Title III funded projects will customize this suggested contribution sliding scale and reflect actual service unit price.

The monthly income amounts are based on the 2017 Federal Poverty Guidelines published in the *Federal Register* on January 31, 2017.
